BACHELOR TRANSFER OPTIONS

Greenville Technical College (GTC) has articulation, transfer, and course equivalency agreements with many four-year institutions, both public and private. GTC works closely with four-year institutions to make the transfer of courses as seamless as possible. The four-year institutions have the final decision on course transfer acceptance. Additionally, the four-year institutions make the final decision whether a course meets elective or program requirement.

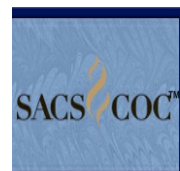
